
S 3NT (I have a club stopper and 14 hcp opposite an opener, I'm definitely going to game. Preempts are effective, they take up a lot of bidding room and make you guess.

I could bid 4H and hope we can take 10 tricks in a likely 7 card trump suit. Maybe my diamonds will set up, after trumps are pulled. Possible.

I could bid 4D, I have 6 of them. Maybe diamonds are the right strain. Minor suit games are usually incorrect when notrump is an option.

So, 3NT it is.)

I get the favorable lead of the Jack of spades as West is void in clubs.



The play is unremarkable. I take:

- 2 spades
- 1 heart
- 6 diamonds
- 1 club
- 10 total tricks making an overtrick
