
S P (I have 12 hcp, a good 5 card diamond suit, and 2 useful 10's. I would evaluate this as a 14 point hand. However, since partner has passed and my suit is a minor, it is unlikely that we have game. Bidding 2D shows 6 diamonds. Bidding 1NT with a weak doubleton in the other major is not great. I have 3 useful hearts and a ruffing value. I'm willing to play 1H in a likely 7 card fit (Moysian fit).

Passed out.


East leads the 3 of spades (I would have preferred the 9 showing no spade honors).




West wins the AK of spades and returns the 5 of hearts to the ace.



East returns the 4 of hearts and I cash the QJ of hearts.



I cash the King of clubs and take the losing club finesse.



East leads the 5 of spades to the Q.
